



FEBRUARY 2024 COMMITTEE REPORT

1. **Mason Fire Department responded to a total of 16 incidents for January 2024 with a 100% response rate:**
 - 10 EMS Calls
 - 1 Motor Vehicle Accident W/ Injuries
 - 1 Motor Vehicle Versus Pedestrian Accident
 - 1 Motor Vehicle Accident W/ No Injuries
 - 3 Water Leaks
2. **An initial inspection was performed on all apparatus by Safe Industries and the remainder of annual maintenance and testing will be concluded next month.**
3. **The department has applied for numerous state and local grants for needed equipment. It is currently preparing a submission for the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) through FEMA.**
4. **The 1998 Pierce Saber that was formerly Engine 71 has been listed for auction on Gov Deals. The listing will be closing in the next few days.**
5. **It has been asked of the fire department to provide additional regularly scheduled staffing including on weekends. The Board and Department will need to explore available options for providing the needed personnel to achieve these goals.**
6. **The department is proposing the reintroduction of the stipend program for volunteers for training, calls, and shifts to counter the increased burden on current personnel.**
7. **In order to remain in compliance with our insurance provider, repairs are still required to address the following issues:**
 - The wall repairs to the front of the fire station.
 - The installation of parking bollards around the station doors and natural gas (22 in total).
8. **We congratulate Firefighter Elvis Warren for obtaining the Tennessee Fire Commission (TFC) Hazardous Materials Operations certification.**
